




Curriculum Map

English	Books	Mathematics
<p>This half term, Year 5 pupils will write a poem based on The Dot, an adventure story inspired by Varjak Paw, and a non-chronological report about the Amazon Rainforest, developing their descriptive language, organisation and ability to write for different purposes. They will explore themes such as self-expression, independence and the natural world through their writing. Pupils will also build their confidence in structuring their ideas clearly for different audiences and purposes.</p> <p>VIPERS tasks (Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanation, Retrieval, and Sequence/Summarise).</p>		<p>This half term, Year 5 pupils will focus on key areas of the British National Curriculum in Maths, including shape, position and direction, and decimals. They will develop their understanding of angles, properties of shapes, and how to describe positions and movements on a grid. Pupils will also build confidence in working with decimals, including recognising place value, comparing numbers and solving problems. Throughout the unit, they will apply their knowledge to a range of reasoning and problem-solving activities.</p>
Science	History/ Geography	Art & Design
<p>Pupils will explore animals, focusing on classification and life cycles. They will learn to group animals such as mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians and fish, and compare their life cycles. Pupils will also use information to predict the gestation periods of different animals.</p>	<p>Year 5 will learn about the Maya civilisation and where it was located in Mesoamerica. They will explore Maya cities, beliefs, calendars, and important foods such as cacao and maize. They will also think about what made the Maya civilisation so distinctive.</p>	<p>Pupils will develop their artistic skills through drawing and architecture. They will create prints, design buildings and evaluate their work to develop their understanding of art and design.</p>
Religious Education	Computing	PSHE
<p>During this half term, Year 5 pupils will explore beliefs, leadership and laws within different communities. They will learn how laws are created, where religious rules come from, how leaders are chosen, and how people find comfort after death.</p>	<p>Across this half term, Year 5 pupils will explore computing concepts linked to space and data. They will learn how data is collected and develop their understanding of binary, including reading, calculating and representing it as text.</p>	<p>They will develop their understanding of money and financial responsibility. They will learn to manage budgets, understand borrowing and online risks, and explore fairness and stereotyping in the workplace.</p>
Music	French	PE
<p>In Year 5 Music, pupils will learn drumming skills and perform simple rhythms with confidence. They will practise keeping a steady beat, changing tempo and playing together as a group.</p>	<p>The pupils will learn the names of clothes. They will describe what they are wearing using colours and simple sentences. They will also practise key grammar to speak and write in French.</p>	<p>In PE the children will develop their skills in cricket and athletics. They will learn key techniques such as batting, bowling and fielding in cricket, alongside improving their running, jumping and throwing in athletics.</p>
