English		Books	Mathematics
This half term in English, the children will be writing a wishing tale based on <i>The King of the Fishes</i> and a character flaw story inspired by <i>The Tale of Marco the Boaster</i> . Throughout these units, pupils will focus on using and applying all of the key writing skills they have developed during Year 4, including ambitious vocabulary, varied sentence structures, punctuation, dialogue and effective paragraphing, to create engaging and imaginative pieces of writing.			In the second half of the summer term in White Rose Year 4 Maths, children will build confidence with decimals, money and time, including converting between different units and solving real-life problems. They will also explore shape and statistics, learning to compare angles, interpret charts and graphs, and describe positions and movements.

In Science this half term, the children will be learning about food chains and how plants and animals depend on one another for survival. They will explore producers, consumers, predators and prey, create and compare different food chains, and learn how changes to habitats and environments can affect living things.	The children will be learning about northern Italy and comparing it with regions of the UK, using maps, photographs and digital tools to investigate different places and environments.		Children will learn where fruits and vegetables come from, how climate and seasons affect when food is grown, and why eating seasonal produce can be healthier and better for the environment.
