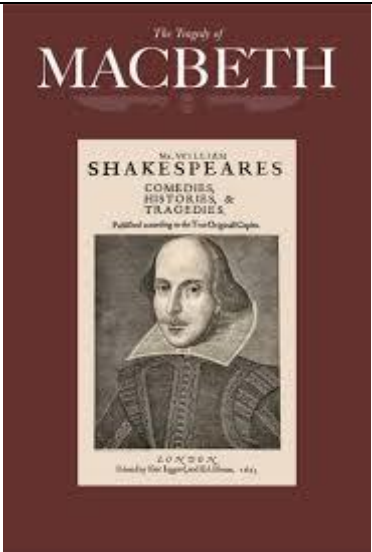




Curriculum Map

English	Books	Mathematics
In English, Year 6 will explore the story of <i>Macbeth</i> and develop their understanding of playscripts by modernising the text and creating their own original adaptations. They will also write a range of poetry and compose heartfelt letters of appreciation to staff members as they celebrate the end of their journey at Hughenden. In addition, year 6 will revisit their Blitz writing from September, producing an enhanced version and reflecting on the progress they have made as confident and accomplished young writers throughout the year.		In Maths, Year 6 will apply and consolidate the skills they have by tackling a range of challenging, real-life problem-solving activities. Year 6 will explore practical aspects of money management, including calculating household bills and understanding how costs can be budgeted and compared. They will be introduced to the concept of mortgages and learn how borrowing money can help people purchase a home, while considering the long-term financial commitments involved. In addition, year 6 will investigate key business concepts such as profit and loss, developing an understanding of how successful enterprises operate. Year 6 will have opportunities to design and develop their own business ideas, calculate potential profits and consider how products can be marketed effectively. This unit will encourage creativity, innovation and problem-solving while helping year 6 recognise the important role mathematics plays in everyday life and the wider world of work.
Science	PE	DT
In Year 6, pupils will develop their understanding of how to maintain a healthy lifestyle and make informed choices about their wellbeing. They will learn about the importance of a balanced diet, exploring the different food groups and how nutrition contributes to growth, energy, and overall health. As part of their science learning, pupils will investigate the human circulatory system, discovering how the heart, blood, and blood vessels work together to transport oxygen and nutrients around the body. 	Year 6 will work in groups to choreograph and perform a dynamic dance routine inspired by a range of iconic 90s pop music. Through this creative process, they will develop their teamwork, communication, and performance skills, learning how to contribute ideas, refine choreography, and work collectively towards a shared artistic vision. Alongside this, the class will dedicate time to preparing for their end-of-year production, a special celebration of their time in primary school. Pupils will rehearse songs, performances and presentations, building confidence and stage presence as they work towards delivering a memorable show for family and friends. This exciting milestone provides an opportunity for year 6 to reflect on their achievements, celebrate their journey together, and create lasting memories as they prepare to move on to the next stage of their education.	Throughout this unit, pupils will explore a range of important Personal, Social, Health and Economic that will support their wellbeing, safety and preparation for the future. They will develop their understanding of alcohol, including its effects on the body and the importance of making informed and responsible choices. Pupils will also learn how to become critical digital consumers, evaluating the reliability of online content and recognising the influence of digital media on thoughts, opinions and behaviours. As part of their online safety education, year 6 will examine the characteristics of positive online relationships, exploring how to communicate respectfully, maintain healthy boundaries, and stay safe in digital environments. They will also learn about the physical and emotional changes associated with puberty, helping them to understand and manage this significant stage of development with confidence and sensitivity. In their Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) learning, year 6 will be introduced to the concepts of conception, pregnancy, and birth, developing an age-appropriate understanding of human reproduction and family life. Alongside this, pupils will gain valuable life-saving skills through first aid education, including how to respond to



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		choking incidents and the principles of basic life support. These practical sessions will equip pupils with the knowledge and confidence to respond appropriately in emergency situations and contribute positively to the safety and wellbeing of others.
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
