


<p>The focus in English is on traditional tales, where students will explore story structure, characters, and common themes. They will develop their descriptive writing skills by practicing using adjectives, sensory details, and engaging language. This will help them create more imaginative and detailed stories.</p> <p>We will be focusing on Year 1 common exception words in our spelling lessons.</p>		  	<p>Year 1 will be focusing on place value within 10 and addition and subtraction to 10.</p> <p>They will learn to recognise, count, and represent numbers up to 10. They will develop their understanding of the value of each digit and begin comparing and ordering numbers. Through practical activities and visual aids, they will develop fluency in simple addition and subtraction within 10, using objects, number lines, and mental strategies.</p>
Science	History/ Geography		Art & Design
<p>In Science, children will learn about the seasons of autumn and winter. They will explore the changes in weather, daylight, temperature, and changes in clothing and activities.</p>	<p>Children explore early photographs and compare them with modern images to understand how life in Britain has changed over time. They learn to ask questions about the people, places, and objects in historical photos, developing an understanding of the past.</p>		<p>In Art, children will be exploring the theme “Make Your Mark” by learning about different types of lines. They will experiment with various line styles such as straight, curved, zigzag, and dotted to create unique patterns and designs. This work helps develop fine motor skills and encourages creativity as children discover how lines can express different ideas in their artwork.</p>
