| <p>Pupils will explore a range of writing genres including a recount of the Tear Thief's exploits, instructions on how to carry out the Tear Thief's job and a character description of the Tear Thief herself.</p> <p>We will also be looking at poetry in a beautiful book called 'The Lost Words', exploring nature themes and using this to continue to build knowledge of the different word classes and how to use them to make our writing interesting for the reader.</p> | |  | <p>In the Autumn term, Year 2 children will focus on building a strong understanding of place value.</p> <p>They will also develop their skills in addition and subtraction by learning to use number bonds to aid their addition, learning methods to help them add across the 10 boundary and to add two-digit numbers. They will also learn to subtract across 10.</p> <p>Homework with focus on fluency with number facts and times tables.</p> | |

| Children will explore animal life cycles and the basic needs of animals. | Children will discover and learn about the geographical features of Wales, Northern Ireland, Scotland and England. They will also learn about other key features of the countries in the UK such as their capital cities. | | Pupils will learn to shape and decorate clay, create a pinch pot and design and make a clay tile. The children will learn practical skills in working with clay and learn to apply artistic techniques in a structured project. | |
