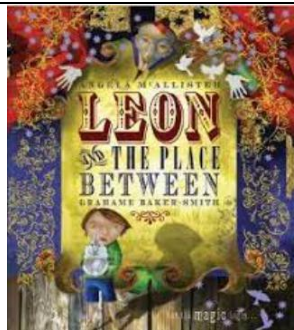

English		Books	Mathematics
This half term, we will be reading 'Leon and the place between' which an exciting book about the circus. Using this text, pupils will continue to work on their use of description through the creation of a circus-based setting description and through writing their own 'finding tale'. They will then apply their newly-built vocabulary to writing a persuasive text, asking people to visit the circus!			In the second Autumn half term, Year 2 children will continue to develop their skills in addition and subtraction by learning to use number bonds to aid their addition, learning methods to help them add across the 10 boundary and to add two-digit numbers. They will also learn to subject across 10. They will also learn to recognise and describe 2D and 3D shapes. Homework with focus on fluency with number facts and times tables.
Science	History	Design and Technology	
Children will explore materials- their uses and properties. They will explore what makes materials suitable or unsuitable for different jobs.	This half term, pupils will be learning about different rulers and how they shaped Britain. We will start with the Romans and Boudica before moving to Richard 1 and King John. We will compare these leaders to Suleiman of the Ottoman empire.	In DT this half term, the children will be designing and creating a functional fairground wheel so that the wheel rotates and the structure stands freely.
