Inclusion is about ensuring our school effectively identifies and supports pupils who are socioeconomically disadvantaged, have special educational needs (SEN) and/or a disability, are known or were previously known to children's social care, or may face additional barriers to their learning and/or wellbeing. It's at the heart of everything we do at Hughenden Primary School, and Mrs Bendall plays a crucial role in making sure every child receives the support they need to succeed.

For parents with pre-school age children we have also partnered with the local RugbyTots group for children to get their first taste of rugby!










