<p>Writing: Setting description – describing London WW2. <p>The human circulatory system – children will learn about the main parts of the circulatory system, the function of the heart, different types of blood vessels, and the role of blood.</p>		<p>In History we will be looking at the outbreak of WW2, the roll of woman in the war, what life was like for an evacuee, and how WW2 changed the lives of people living through it.</p>		<p>In Art, we will be focusing on drawing and sketching, with an emphasis on how symbolism in art can be used to convey meaning. The children will explore a range of drawing techniques and develop their skills through practical activities. We will be applying these techniques to create a powerful final piece inspired by street art and graffiti, encouraging personal expression and creative interpretation.</p>

<p>Children will be studying why religion looks different around the world. They will build on comparisons about the origins of the Abrahamic religions, children consider how culture, tradition, migration and interpretation can affect how some religious practices are observed.</p>		<p>We will be looking at the history of Bletchley Park, historical figures and computer science. Children learn about code-breaking and password hacking as well as decoding messages.</p>		<p>In PSHE, we will be exploring respectful relationships; understand that respect is a two-way thing; how we treat others is how we can expect to be treated and explore other people's attitudes and ideas and to begin to challenge these. The children will learn how to resolve disputes and conflicts using a range of strategies as well as understand the process and emotions related to grief and loss.</p>

<p>Theme – Autumn Notes (songs include Dance of the Leaves) Listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory Use and understand musical notations to enable them to appreciate and understand a wide range of musical genres.</p>		<p><b>A l'école</b> - In this unit pupils will learn about 10 school subjects and how to conjugate the verb "to study", along with an introduction to time and an expansion of opinions. They will be able to talk about the subjects they like and dislike at school and at what time or day they study various subjects.</p>		<p>Football – children will work on increasing confidence and skill, understanding tactics, teamwork, and key rules, while improving physical fitness and coordination.
