#### Parking at drop off and pick up

As a school we work hard to reduce congestion and traffic pollution in the local areas and as our school continues to grow, we are aware that pollution levels are increasing. We are, once again, asking for your help in the following ways and to make you aware of a few facts:

- Please switch off your engines while waiting for the children
- Pollution from engines affects us all and can exacerbate ongoing health issues such as asthma
- It is **illegal** to sit in a parked car with the engine running
- It is an obstruction to park within 10 metres of any corner.

Only parents with Parking Permits issued by the school can drive onto the school site. Please make use of the valuable crossing patrol or park at the Village Hall and walk to the school.

#### **Crocodile Trail**

It's 8.45 in the morning and the roads around the school are thick with traffic. Parents are dropping off children with their engines still running, while others drive around searching for a parking space. It's a problem that occurs outside most schools, and a problem that could be helped by a Crocodile Trail.

More commonly known as a "Walking Bus", the <u>Crocodile Trail will allow children to walk from Hughenden</u> Village Hall to School with the supervision of school staff and some parent volunteers.

We will be starting the Scheme w/c Monday 9th September 2019 which means the first crocodile walk will be Tuesday 10th September 2019. Priority will be given to children who usually travel to school by car.

Permission forms have been emailed to parents via eschools which need to be completed before taking part. These are also available in the school office. If you want any further information about the scheme, please contact Mrs Ali or Mrs Wainwright, The Crocodile Trail Coordinators.

#### **Rotary Shoe Box Appeal**

# School Nursing Team

Children in Years 1-6 will be seen by the School Nursing Team on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> November 2019. This is for a flu vaccination clinic. If you would like to opt your child out of this visit, you need to complete the form that was emailed out to you and return to the school office. If they do not receive this information, they will be seen by the School Nursing Team. The opt out form is relevant to the clinic.

Children in Foundation and Year 6 will be visited by the School Nursing Team, this is a routine visit which is in line with the National Childhood Measurement Programme. Details to follow once we receive them.

#### **Parliamentary Assembly**
