Key Stage 1 Educational Visit to Wycombe Museum – Wednesday 21st June 2017

As part of our topic on Changes in Living Memory, Year 1 have the opportunity to take part in some interactive workshops discovering the history of toys, at the Wycombe Museum.

The workshops will compare old and new toys, will allow the children to handle replica old toys and include craft activities. This trip will provide the opportunity for children to develop their speaking and listening skills and investigative skills to find out about the differences and similarities between now and then.

During the day, the children will be able to visit the museum to discover more about our local history.

The children will be required to wear school uniform. Lunch will be eaten outside so please ensure your child has sun cream and a named sun hat. School will provide packed lunch, as well as, the morning fruit snack.
