

## How to help at home

At Hughenden Primary School we follow the National Curriculum 2014. This leaflet gives a brief outline of the knowledge and skills being learned in the curriculum in your class this term.

## English

### Tom's Sausage Lion by Michael Morpurgo

- To write a newspaper report and a diary entry
- To write in role to explore characters and events
- To develop creative responses to a text through storytelling, drama and poetry.

### A River by Marc Martin

Grammar includes use of powerful verbs and adjectives; punctuating direct speech; apostrophes in possessives; grammatical terms from Appendix 2 of National Curriculum; adverbials, prepositions, pronouns, multi clause sentences using a variety of conjunctions.

## Maths

The children will focus on the following topics:

- Money
- Shape - squares, rectangles and triangles
- Symmetry
- Tessellations
- Time (seconds, 24-hour clock)
- Recall multiplication and division facts
- Please also ensure that your child has access to rmeasimaths/ttrockstars as often as possible at home.

## Science

The focus this term is on the following topics:

- States of matter
- Living Things and their Habitats
