Year 3 - Forest School Sessions – Spring 2019 – Pipers Corner School

I am delighted to be able to let you know that Year 3 will be attending a series of Forest School sessions for the following two terms, kindly funded by Pipers Corner School, Pipers Lane, Great Kingshill. The sessions will take place every Friday afternoon at Pipers Corner School with myself and Mrs Debbie Easterbrook, their Forest School Leader.

We will be leaving Hughenden after lunch to walk up to Pipers Corner on fenced public footpaths, returning back to school for 3.30pm. During the sessions the children will have the chance to experience a variety of outdoor learning which will teach them new skills, enhance their knowledge and understanding of local woodland diversity and provide the opportunity for fun and exercise in the fresh air.

The class will be split into two groups of approximately 15, and the children remaining at school will be continuing with their computing lessons with Mr Churchill. On 21 June, during the final session, Mr Churchill will accompany us, and the whole class will attend an outdoor celebration at Pipers. I'm sure you will agree that this is a really exciting opportunity for your children and we are very grateful to Pipers Corner School for offering the use of their facilities and Forest School Leader to Hughenden.

In order to fully participate, all children attending will need to bring a change of clothes each Friday in a named carrier bag. They will need a long sleeved t-shirt, fleece/jumper, long trousers, waterproof trousers, waterproof coat and wellington boots/waterproof walking shoes as we will be outside for the whole of each session, whatever the weather. The children will be informed after half term which group they are in, A or B, but in the meantime, please could you return the attached permission slip and parental consent form to the Office so that we can allocate places. Group A may also wish to bring a hat and gloves until the weather warms up. The dates are as follows:
