## Parking at drop off and pick up

As a school we work hard to reduce congestion and traffic pollution in the local areas and as our school continues to grow, we are aware that pollution levels are increasing. We are, once again, asking for your help in the following ways and to make you aware of a few facts:

- Please switch off your engines while waiting for the children
- Pollution from engines affects us all and can exacerbate ongoing health issues such as asthma
- It is illegal to sit in a parked car with the engine running
- It is an obstruction to park within 10 metres of any corner.

Only parents with Parking Permits issued by the school are allowed to drive onto the school site. Please make use of the valuable crossing patrol or park at the Village Hall and walk to the school.

## Sports Day - Monday 15th July, 9.30am

I am writing to inform you about **Foundation and Key Stage 1 Sports Day**. We are intending to hold the sports day on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July, weather permitting and the event will begin at 9:30 am. If your child attends Hoppers on a Monday, then they will be joining in. If this isn't a normal day for your child for Hoppers please contact Mrs Brinkworth. You are welcome to wait on the school field after dropping your children off as they will be registered in their classrooms prior to the event.

After the children have completed their activities you are welcome to stay for a family picnic. Please feel free to bring your own lunch, but school packed lunches will be provided for all children in Key Stage 1 in addition to this. The PTA will be providing refreshments during the event which you will be able to purchase.

After the picnic the children will return to their classes for registration. However if parents wish to take their children home they can do so <u>after registration</u>. Children who remain with us will watch the Key Stage 2 races and the presentation of the winning House cup!

**The Key Stage 2 Sports Day** races will begin at 1:15pm after the children have returned to class for afternoon registration. Parents can come to school to picnic on the field with their children from 12pm and will then be able to watch year 3, 4, 5 & 6 participate in the Sports Day activities.

Children are welcome to wear a t-shirt in their colour house. Please feel free to ask your child's class teacher if you are unsure of the house your child has been allocated.
