Key principles of Mathematical teaching at Hughenden Primary

- 1. The use of the concrete, pictorial and abstract pedagogy should be at the heart of every mathematics lesson at Hughenden.
- 2. Teaching staff will strive to maximise the potential of each child using a variety of strategies; which promote a broad and deep understanding of mathematical concepts.
- 3. Talk for maths will be at the heart of every lesson, with children given adequate time to share, explore and reflect on their mathematical understanding.
- 4. Children are encouraged to have growth mind set and know that through effort and practice everyone can succeed.
- 5. Teaching staff will use a range of timely assessment for learning tools to quickly identify those children who need an intervention to make progress.
- 6. Pupils are expected to actively contribute to every lesson through participation, recorded work and response to marking.
 - 7. Teaching staff will seek to promote links between mathematical concepts and find crosscurricular opportunities to deepen and apply children's understanding.
