Costumes

For the both performances and the dress rehearsal (Thursday morning during school time) please could each child wear some jeans (stone washed if you have them) and a checked shirt with their school shoes. This is a very simple costume that most of you will have at home all ready. If anyone has straw hats (such as a farmer may wear) and/or neckerchiefs, the children may also wear them.

They will be dancing in these costumes and will be moving around a lot so school shoes will be the most appropriate foot wear. Please send your child in school uniform on Thursday 17th with their costume in a carrier bag.

Lunch

On Thursday 17th during the Dress Rehearsal children will need a packed lunch as we will not be back at school until the afternoon.

Drop off

On both performance evenings if you have tickets to see the show that night, please drop your child off at the Oak Room door at 6:45pm where Mrs Wainwright will be there to greet them. If however you are watching the show on a different night, please drop your children off at the Oak Room door at 7:15pm.

Collection

The show is expected to finish around 9:10pm and this is anticipated that children will be available for collection at the Oak Room door (where they were dropped off) about 9:30pm (dependant on the length of the performance). Please be aware that no cars should be driven behind the Swan so please park elsewhere before walking round to the Oak Room door to collect your child. Children will be dismissed to their parents by our school staff (Mrs Wainwright, Mrs Fletcher and Mrs Sumners) from the Oak Room.

On Friday 18th March as children will have had a late night the night before, if you so wish, children may arrive at school for break at 10:30am to commence lessons at 10:45am.

We are all really looking forward to the performance and hope you will enjoy it. I understand that there will be DVD's available to purchase at a later date.
