How to help at home

- Read to or listen to your child read regularly. Talk about the book and ask challenging questions.
- Use "Look, Cover, Write, Check" method to learn weekly spellings.
- Use Nessy and RMEasimaths regularly.
- Continue to read and spell common exception words.
- Know multiplication and division facts for 2, 3's 5 and 10's.
- Support with Maths and English homework.
- Talk together about what your child enjoys at school.
- Explore the natural world and encourage your child to ask questions.

Year 2

Dear Parents & Children,

At Hughenden Primary School we follow the National Curriculum 2014. This leaflet gives a brief outline of the knowledge and skills being learned in the curriculum in your class this term.

English-The Adventures of Egg Box Dragon by Richard Adams.

The children need to focus on the following:

- Use expanded noun phrases.
- Write a newspaper report.
- Use simple conjunctions (e.g. also, as well, because, but) to link ideas logically.
- Use present tense and past tense correctly.
- · Learning to spell more words with contracted forms.
- Write and perform poetry.
- Year 2 grammar (National Curriculum 2014).
- Year 2 spellings (National Curriculum 2014 states which spelling patterns and list of common exception words).

Maths

The children need to focus on the following:

- Know 2, 5 and 10 x tables off by heart and be able to count in 3s fluently.
- Know number bonds to 10 and 20 mentally and double numbers up to 20.
- Understand the symbols < = >
- · To find the difference when subtracting.
- Add and recognise money. (Pence and Pound)
- · Recognise and solve repeated addition.

- Partition a 2-digit number.
- Add and subtract 2-digit numbers crossing ten.

Science-Animals including humans

The children need to focus on the following:

- Describe how animals and humans change as they grow.
- Explore the basic needs of humans and animals.
- To identify healthy and unhealthy foods.
- To give reasons why humans need exercise.
- The importance of hygiene.
