## Year 5 Walking Tour of The Rye – Wednesday 21 October 2020

As part of this term's Topic learning on the Anglo-Saxons, we have been offered a fabulous chance to dive into the history of the Rye in High Wycombe by a local historian. As a precursor to this, Mrs Madalyn Baskerville provided artefacts for the children to handle in a Covid-safe manner last Friday and will be delivering a lesson this Wednesday afternoon on the legacy of the Anglo-Saxons locally.

The walk on Wednesday 21 October will focus on the Romans leaving High Wycombe and the Anglo Saxons arriving, especially the effect this had on land use and local trade.

Children will need to be **dropped off at the Wycombe Rye car park next to the lido for 8.50 am**. After the tour, which will last about one hour, we will walk back through Hughenden Park to school for lunch. If the weather looks good, we will eat lunch in the park before returning to school. Due to the nature of the trip, please could **all children bring a packed lunch, water bottle, hand sanitiser and have a coat and sturdy, comfortable shoes to walk in**.
