Esafety and Safeguarding Presentation by James Down - Monday 24th April at 7:30pm

Sadly we live in a world where children are easily exposed to inappropriate and, quite frankly, explicit adult language and visual images. This can have long term consequences on their emotional development and cause lasting trauma.

I am privileged to sit on the Safeguarding Board for Buckinghamshire and both myself and Linda O'Malley met James at an Emotional Wellbeing Conference earlier this year. We were very impressed at his knowledge and how he approached a sensitive subject leaving the audience much better informed about the dangers our young people face and the opportunities to reduce the risk. Jame's engaging manner, which is difficult to convey with such a serious subject matter, remained with us and that is why we have booked him for this vital meeting.

We would strenuously urge all parents, regardless of their children's age or their own knowledge of internet safety, to make every effort to attend.
