Y4 Educational Visit to the River Rye, High Wycombe

Year 4 will be visiting the Rye Park in High Wycombe on Wednesday 18 October 2017 as part this term's topic 'Rivers, Mountains and Coasts' where they will be investigating the River Rye. They will be outdoors for the morning and so will need to wear school uniform and sturdy school shoes or trainers. Each child will need a water bottle, packed lunch and waterproof coat.

We will be travelling to the park by coach, fitted with 3-point seat belts, leaving school after registration. After their investigations have been completed the children will walk to Church House where they will eat their lunch, and then join the rest of the school at Hughenden Church for Harvest Festival.
