## HUGHENDEN PARENTS' PARKING REMINDER AND IMPORTANT GUIDELINES

As you are aware, the area around our school is busy in the morning and at the end of the school day. Parents who park irresponsibly are potentially placing children walking to school in danger. Hughenden Parents' Parking Promise is a campaign that aims to promote safe and considerate parking.

The Hughenden Parents' Parking Promise asks parents to:

- Observe Zig-Zag Lines directly outside our school gates and maintain the area clear from parked cars thereby increasing visibility for pedestrians and other drivers
- Park carefully and considerately to ensure the drives of neighbouring properties remain accessible and never within 10 metres of a road junction. Please ensure that you also do not reverse into a neighbour's drive to turn around
- Between 8:30am and 4:30pm please do not drive onto the school premises or park around the roundabout (unless already in possession of an issued parking permit)
- Consider using the car park at the Village Hall or opposite the Harrow and walking to and from school (especially during the Walk to School month – October). Please help us to keep the area around school safe by parking correctly and considerately therefore, protecting lives of all the children attending our school.

This is a joint initiative between Hughenden Primary School, Thames Valley Police and Buckinghamshire County Council to make our school a safe place.
