Y3/4 Visit to Living Rainforest, Newbury - Tuesday 6th June 2017

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to announce that we have arranged an exciting trip to the 'Living Rainforest' in Newbury. This will be an extremely valuable learning experience for your child and will support our PSHE, Science and English work.

During the day, children will explore the idea of 'Sustainable Development' and its impact on different people, places and environments. This follows on from our learning about the Daintree Rainforest in Australia during our Persuasive Writing unit in English. Children will also experience what it is like to visit a rainforest and learn about the different plants and animals.

The trip will take place during normal school hours, with the coach leaving at 9:00am. We will return to school at approximately 3.30pm so we expect that the children can be collected normal time.

To cover the cost of the visit, we are requesting a voluntary contribution of £20 per child. If insufficient contributions are received, the trip may have to be cancelled. If you are having difficulties in making a contribution, please speak to your child's teacher in the first instance.

On the day your child will need:

- A waterproof coat
- Packed lunch in a disposable bag - no hot dinners as we will be eating at the Living Rainforest.
- Children need to wear their usual school uniform and comfortable walking shoes.
