As you may be aware, this term in Year 6 we are studying the Ancient Greeks. As part of our cross-curricular learning, we have found an exciting opportunity to extend your child's learning at the Ashmolean Museum in Oxford on the 15 October 2019.

We will be taking part in a fabulous workshop about 'Life in Ancient Greece', where we will be understanding more about life of an ancient Greek and how the classical world still impacts on us today, the different kinds of materials used by craftsmen and beginning to understand how archaeological evidence can be used to learn about the past. We will also be looking for similarities and differences between life in Ancient Greece and today as well as understanding that objects can give us information about how people lived and worked.

We have arranged for a lunch area within the educational area of the museum and as such children will need a packed lunch and water bottle. Following the workshop, children will have the opportunity to briefly explore the museum's art and contents, extending their learning further.
