Y3/4 Visit to Living Rainforest, Newbury - Tuesday 6th June 2017

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to announce that we have arranged an exciting trip to the 'Living Rainforest' in Newbury. This will be an extremely valuable learning experience for your child and will support our Topic, Science and English work.

During the day, children will learn about the requirements of living things for growth and survival. They will explore how plants make their own food and about the diets of animals. Children will also experience what it is like to visit a rainforest.

The trip will take place during normal school hours, with the coach leaving at 9:00am. We will return to school at approximately 3.30pm so we expect that the children can be collected normal time.
