Remote Learning and Class DoJo

Early feedback from parents relating to the use of Class DoJo has been very positive and we are seeing increasing numbers of pupils and parents signing up to use the app. Please do try to upload work regularly to the class page

so that teachers can provide feedback and support as required. Teachers would like to see regular evidence that children are engaging with learning. Remember this can be in a range of formats. Aim to submit something each day.

Please remember to let us know if your child is ill if they are at home. We still have to report 'attendance' to the DfE and we want to be aware so that we understand why they might not be able to complete work. Also, please let us know if your child tests positive for coronavirus.

If you have a few moments to spare, please complete the short questionnaire below to give your views on the remote learning we have in place. All teachers are now offering live 'check ins' via Teams or Zoom at least twice weekly which are supplemented by access to live lessons from other platforms which fit into our half term curriculum planning. We also offer weekly access to a school assembly and today there was a live singing assembly from Mrs Sumner which many of our pupils attended.
