Year 4 Educational Visit to Oxford Botanical Gardens – Monday 25 June 2018

As part of our science topic on Living things and their habitat, Year 4 has the opportunity to take part in some interactive workshops at the Oxford Botanical Gardens. The workshops will introduce the children to the concept of sustainability and how Climate change has impacted our planet. During the day, the children will also be able to explore the different Glasshouses to gain an appreciation of the diversity of plant life and explore the Gardens to decide if they are eco-friendly.

The children will be required to wear school uniform. Lunch may be eaten outside so please ensure your child has sun cream and a named sun hat. As part of our trip we will be looking at the environmental impact of waste and recycling. Please can you provide your child with a 'waste-free' packed lunch using little or no non-recyclable products all contained in a re-usable lunchbox that can be returned to school. The waste produced will be weighed and compared to the weight of any recyclable items in order to demonstrate how much we throw away.

We would be grateful if you could send a voluntary contribution of £18.00 per child in order to cover the cost of coach hire to and from Oxford and for the workshops. If we do not receive adequate funding, unfortunately the trip may not be able to go ahead.

We will be leaving school promptly at 9.05 am in order to arrive at the gardens in time for the start of their first session. We will arrive back by the end of the school day.
