How to enter...

The best one in the school will be recorded, the children performing it – audio or video. You could set your song to a familiar tune, or make a new one, draw some pictures to help illustrate your poem, or find some winter clothes to wear... there are no rules - be creative!

You have until the Friday, 16th October, to hand in your poem to JRSOs.

The following week we will make the video and enter it into competition by 23rd October!
