Dear Parents,

We are pleased to share with you our plans to change our KS2 school uniform coming into effect from September 2016. We are looking forward to launching this with all parents on Tuesday 19th July at our Open Evening between 4.00-6.15pm.

I have attached our Uniform Policy which has been agreed with Governors outlining the changes.

We will phase the changes in throughout the next academic year with everyone in the new uniform by September 2017. This way, you will only have to purchase new uniform when your child outgrows their old one.

The uniform for Foundation and KS1 remains the same.

We have consulted all the KS2 children on the proposed changes to our school uniform as 'pupil voice' plays a very important role at Hughenden. We are delighted to announce that the majority are in favour of our changes and feel it would project a smart image to our wider community, providing a distinctive and mature impression of our school. This will also support the transition to Year 7 in secondary school.

With this change, we are also switching to a different supplier for our uniform and this will be available to purchase by the end of this term. PMG Schoolwear will continue to provide our uniform for Foundation and KS1 children for the next academic year but will not be replacing their stock as they run out.

Our new supplier, Ultimate Incentives, based in Great Kingshill will, we believe, offer a flexible, friendly service. Parents can purchase through our online portal on our school website for free delivery to school or in person at their offices in Great Kingshill with payment choices to suit everyone (card, cheque, cash). Samples of the new uniform will be available to view at our forthcoming Open Evening with order forms to place your orders if you wish.

School Uniform

We are in the process of changing our uniform supplier. The 2016-2017 academic year will be a transition year to facilitate this. From September 2017 all KS2 children will be in the same uniform as listed below. The new supplier for KS2 from September 2016 will be Ultimate Incentives, based locally in Great Kingshill, Bucks.

Our current suppliers, PMG Schoolwear, in High Wycombe, Bucks will continue to provide uniform for the new intake for September 2016. We will transition across to Ultimate Incentives for all our school uniform from September 2017 onwards.

Our school uniform has been chosen for comfort and practicality. Sweatshirts, cardigans, jumpers and book bags all bear the school logo. Other items can be purchased in department stores. It is essential that all items are clearly named. This ensures they can be returned to the correct child.

KS2 Boys

White Shirt (long or short sleeved) School tie Navy blue v-neck jumper with the school logo Grey trousers or shorts in the Summer White, grey, navy or black socks

KS2 Girls

White Shirt (long or short sleeved) School tie Navy blue v-neck jumper with the school logo Grey trousers, skirt or pinafore dress White, grey, navy or black socks Blue/white checked dress in the Summer

KS1 Boys

Navy sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo Pale blue polo shirt Grey trousers or shorts White, grey, navy or black socks

KS1 Girls

Grey skirt or grey pinafore dress or smart grey trousers Checked blue/white dresses during the Summer Term White or navy socks, grey or black tights

All Children:

Sensible flat shoes - black Wellington boots Trainers, plimsolls and socks Named drawstring PE Bag (school logo bag available from Ultimate Incentives): Navy tracksuit, top and bottoms, Navy shorts, white t-shirt, PE Socks School Bookbag with logo Drinking bottle for water – school have bottles to purchase @ £3 each with a spare lid supplied Lunchbox for KS2 children

ALL ITEMS MUST BE LABELLED AND NAMED PLEASE

Long hair should be tied back neatly away from the face. No extreme hairstyles or hair gel is permitted. Any hair accessories should be in the school colours. Nail varnish is not permitted.

No jewellery is permitted in school except for medical alert items.
