Y3 Visit to High Wycombe Chair Museum and Rye Park

Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 3 will be visiting the High Wycombe Chair Museum on Wednesday 19th October 2016. This will enhance our Design and Technology project on chair making, linked to our Local History topic, which the children are covering this term. The children will also learn about the history of the local area through a guided walk towards the Rye Park.

In order for the trip to run we would like to ask for a voluntary contribution of £9.50 per child, which includes the coach fare and museum workshops. If we do not secure sufficient funding, we may need to reconsider.
